

MOON RISE MONTESSORI PRESCHOOL FEE STRUCTURE 2023

Registration fees

Upon application, a fee of R500 is payable. Once your child has been successfully enrolled, a further payment of R1500 is payable, from which the registration fee will be deducted which needs to be paid in full to secure your child's place at Moon Rise Montessori. This amount is a once off non-refundable fee.

Waiting list fee/application fee	This fee is a once off amount that will be deducted from the placement fee, upon enrolment	R500
Placement fee	This fee is a once off non-refundable amount payable per child	R1500
To secure a place for your child, the Placement fee needs to be paid in full.

Additional Information:

- Fees are payable in advance before the 3rd of every month and are payable over a **12-month period**.
- There is a 5% sibling discount available, which is deductible from the youngest child's fees.
- The school day starts at 08h00 and ends at 13h00.
- Late payments (after 7th of every month) will have a late payment surcharge of R300 to compensate for excess banking fees/interest rates on late payments.
- Children who stay for the mid-day and full day options will be given the opportunity to take part in a second work period.
- Children who require an afternoon nap will be offered this between 13h30 and 15h00. Should you wish for your child to not sleep at all or only sleep for a certain time, please inform your class teacher so that we can ensure that your child can be settled into their afternoon routine.
- Aftercare is available from 13h30 until 17h30 Monday to Thursday and **17h00 on a Friday**.

Additional Costs:

- Extramural activities offered by independent practitioners are not included in the monthly tuition fees. These fees must be arranged between the parent and practitioner.
- Special items purchased from the school such as T-shirts, tracksuits, sunhats, face shields etc. may be purchased and added to your monthly account.
- Late pick ups will be charged **at R10 per 10 minutes after 17h30** Monday to Thursday and after **17h00 on Fridays**. These funds will be paid directly to the staff member on duty who has had to work late due to the late pickup.
- Holiday club will be available for certain termly holidays, these fees are inclusive of your monthly fees. We ask that you book your child's place in the Holiday club times so that we can plan for activities and have adequate supervision during this time.
- Every Friday, we have Tuckshop. Every child gets a turn to be 'shopkeeper' throughout the school year, where they will provide a small, relatively healthy and Halaal treat on that day. Tuckshop dates will be communicated at the beginning of each term.
- The children are requested to bring **R10.00 on Fridays** to 'buy' their tuckshop treat. This is a fun way for the children to learn about buying and selling, as well as a low-grade fund raiser for the school throughout the year.

Food:

- For children who will be arriving early and need to eat their breakfast at school, please ensure that you pack a healthy breakfast with enough milk for one serving if they will be needing milk for cereal etc.
- Please pack a healthy lunch for your child to enjoy at 12h30 each day.
- For children who stay for aftercare, please ensure that they have enough healthy snack snacks to sustain them until the end of the school day.
- Fruit, bread, eggs, and veggie sticks will be provided as part of the morning snack time.

General Information:

- Payments can be made via EFT.
- Termination of enrolment and/or withdrawal of a child is one calendar months' notice. Should you fail to provide notice in writing one calendar month prior to your child leaving, you will still be liable for that calendar month's school fees which are payable in advance.
- Any holidays undertaken by families during times when the school is open (school term dates) does not exempt a child from paying school fees for the duration that they are not at school. School fees are worked out on an annual rate and either paid annually, termly or over a 12-month period.
- Children who give notice in the month of November are still liable for December's fees.

Requirements:

- A backpack that is sized appropriately to a little person's needs (inside this backpack there must be adequate space for a change of clothing, lunch bags and general personal belongings.)
- Water boots to stay at school during winter months.
- A pair of slippers or slipper socks to be worn inside the classroom during school time.
- Sun hat.
- Sunscreen.
- A water bottle.
- Lunch packed into a lunch box small enough to fit into the backpack used for keeping belongings in.
- A spare set of clothing.

Requirements for children who are transitioning from nappy to toilet:

- Comfy clothing that is easy to get on and off.
- 6 x spare sets of underwear.
- Spare change of clothing in case of toileting misses.
- Wet wipes.

Requirements for children who are still dependent on nappies

- 6 x nappies.
- Bum cream.
- Wet wipes.
- Spare change of clothing.
